Overview

The Pre-Law Committee at Le Moyne College (LMC) will serve as a selection committee that will interview and select potential students each year who may fit the established criteria for entry to Albany Law School (ALB) after their junior year. Le Moyne College has no obligation to nominate a student or students to the Albany Law School, even if the student fulfills the criteria.

Le Moyne students selected for participation by the LMC Pre-Law Committee will fulfill the established terms and conditions as well as fit the eligibility criteria set forth below. Once selected, participating students are expected to continue to meet all established terms, conditions and academic criteria.

Overall, participating students will complete all course requirements, with the exception of electives, for their major by the end of the junior year of undergraduate studies at Le Moyne College before entering the first year of law school at Albany Law. Le Moyne students will receive their bachelor's degree upon successful completion of that first year of law school.
